



Pecan Street Inc. Energy Internet Demonstration
Addendum to Participation Agreement
Enhanced Solar Rebates Participation Agreement

This agreement is an addendum to the Participation Agreement between Pecan Street Project Inc., a Texas non-profit corporation (“Pecan Street Inc.”), and _____
[RESIDENT’S NAME] (“Resident”) (collectively, the “Parties”).

The Parties specifically acknowledge that all provisions of the Participation Agreement govern this Addendum and the Parties’ obligations pursuant to this Addendum unless specifically stated otherwise.

Rebate Overview

To facilitate achieving these research goals, Pecan Street Inc. offers a rebate of \$0.50 per watt for south-facing PV installations, \$0.75 per watt for west-facing PV installations and \$0.80 per watt for combined south- and west-facing installations with an inverter for each orientation and at least 2 kilowatts in west-facing panels. The incentive will be capped at 6 kilowatts to ensure funding assists the maximum number of participants. Enhanced solar rebates will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Residents will be notified when Pecan Street Inc. commits all available rebate funding.

Eligibility Criteria

To participate in the Enhanced Solar Rebate Program, Resident must meet the following criteria:

- Own a home in Austin’s Mueller Community
- Participate in, and comply with, all requirements of Austin Energy’s Residential PV Rebate Program
- Commit to participate in the Home Systems Deployment phase of the Pecan Street Inc. Energy Internet Demonstration by signing and returning the Participation Agreement
- Select an inverter for Resident’s PV system that is capable of reporting detailed power production information over an Internet connection. If Resident’s PV installer is not sure whether the selected inverter meets this requirement, he/she should contact Pecan Street Project by calling 512-782-9213.
- Grant Pecan Street Inc. periodic access to Resident’s roof, at a time that is convenient to Resident, to test the performance of the PV system.

Roles and Responsibilities

As part of the mutual considerations forming this Agreement, Pecan Street Inc.’s roles and responsibilities in this Agreement include:

- Paying to Resident or Resident’s designee a rebate on a per-watt basis (with a maximum eligible deployment of 6 kW) for solar PV deployed on Resident’s roof. The rebate is \$0.50 per watt for south-facing PV installations, \$0.75 per watt for west-facing PV installations and \$0.80 per watt for combined south- and west-facing installations with a minimum of 2 kilowatts in west-facing PV.
- Paying the rebate to Resident or Resident’s designee within 60 days of receiving verification from Austin Energy that the PV system passed final inspection.

As part of the mutual considerations forming this Agreement, Resident’s roles and responsibilities in this Agreement include:

- Executing and returning to Pecan Street Inc. the Pecan Street Inc. Energy Internet Demonstration Participation Agreement and meeting all requirements of that agreement
- Complying with Austin Energy’s Residential PV Rebate Program
- Complying with Pecan Street Inc.’s Enhanced Solar Rebate program procedures, as outlined in the “Enhanced Solar Rebate Procedures”
- Completing the PV installation within the time frame stated in Austin Energy’s Letter of Intent.

PV System Data Rights and Responsibilities

Resident specifically acknowledges that data from the solar PV systems that are the subject of this Addendum are covered within the data legal interests that are addressed in the “Home Systems Deployment Data Rights and Responsibilities” section of the Participation Agreement to which this agreement is an addendum.
